

Annual Meeting & Elections

The Annual HDA Mtg. did not take place in February due to a lack of quorum. The total number of votes received by the Inspector of Elections was 177, which fell short of the 708 needed to reach a quorum (51% of membership). The Annual HDA meeting & Elections has been rescheduled to March 1, 2017. The number of votes needed is reduced to 347 (25% of membership) to hold the Annual Meeting & Elections.
